NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR E-FILING

ELECTRONIC FILING: PA MOTOR FUELS TAX REPORT

To improve efficiency and accuracy for you and the department, the Pennsylvania Motor Fuels Tax Report must be filed electronically starting with the September 2016 report, due October 20, 2016.

HOW DO I E-FILE?

Thousands of businesses file returns and remit payments electronically each week using the department's easy-to-use online e-TIDES platform. To learn how to register and use e-TIDES, as well as to get a list of tax software that is compatible with the system, visit the department's website at www.revenue.pa.gov and select e-TIDES.

WHAT IF I DON'T E-FILE?

You could be penalized 10 percent of the tax amount due for an improperly filed Pennsylvania Motor Fuels Tax Report starting with the September 2016 report, due October 20, 2016. In addition, the taxpayer's distributor permit may be suspended or revoked by the department.
