## GENERAL FUND

General Fund collections of $\$ 2,920.1$ million for the month of April were $\$ 390.2$ million, or $\mathbf{1 1 . 8 \%}$, below the official estimate. Fiscal year 2009-10 collections of $\$ 22,841.9$ million were below the official estimate by $\$ 1,109.8$ million, or 4.6\%.

- Total Corporation Tax collections of $\$ 436.6$ million for the month of April were $\$ 147.7$ million, or $25.3 \%$, below the official estimate. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 431.0$ million, or $9.8 \%$, below estimate.
- Sales and Use Tax (SUT) collections of $\$ 708.5$ million were $\$ 26.7$ million, or $3.6 \%$, below estimate. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 342.9$ million, or $4.9 \%$, below estimate.
- Total Personal Income Tax (PIT) collections of $\$ 1,398.0$ million for the month of April were $\$ 128.6$ million, or $8.4 \%$, below estimate. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 264.5$ million, or $3.1 \%$, below the official estimate.
- Realty Transfer Tax (RTT) revenues of $\$ 23.9$ million were $\$ 4.6$ million, or 23.6\%, above estimate. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 8.6$ million, or $3.8 \%$, above estimate.
- Inheritance Tax revenues of $\$ 69.1$ million were $\$ 1.8$ million, or $2.7 \%$, above estimate. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 11.2$ million, or $1.8 \%$, below estimate.
- Other tax revenue including Cigarette, Malt Beverage, Liquor, and other miscellaneous tax collections totaled $\$ 117.9$ million for the month of April.
- Nontax revenue collections for the month of April were below the official estimate by $\$ 96.2$ million. Year-to-date collections are $\$ 103.4$ million below the official estimate.

## MOTOR LICENSE AND GAMING FUNDS

Motor License Fund collections of $\$ 301.5$ million in April were $\$ 5.2$ million, or $1.7 \%$, below the official estimate. Fiscal year 2009-10 collections of $\$ 2,231.1$ million were $\$ 15.7$ million, or $0.7 \%$, below the official estimate.

The State Gaming Fund collected $\$ 65.7$ million in April. Fiscal year-to-date collections for the fund total $\$ 606.3$ million.
