GENERAL FUND

General Fund Collections of \$3.2 billion for the month of May were \$402.4 million, or 14.2 percent, above the official estimate. Fiscal year 2021-22 collections of \$43.9 billion were \$4.9 billion, or 12.5 percent, above estimate.

- Total Corporation Tax collections of \$510.9 million for the month of May were \$129.5 million above the official estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$1.2 billion, or 24.4 percent, above estimate.
- Sales and Use Tax (SUT) collections of \$1.2 billion were \$129.1 million above estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$1.0 billion, or 8.7 percent, above estimate.
- Total Personal Income Tax (PIT) collections of \$1.1 billion for the month of May were \$126.9 million above estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$2.2 billion, or 15.2 percent, above the official estimate.
- Realty Transfer Tax (RTT) revenues of \$69.3 million were \$13.9 million above estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$153.9 million, or 24.9 percent, above estimate.
- Inheritance Tax revenues of \$132.3 million were \$15.6 million above estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$159.8 million, or 12.6 percent, above estimate.
- Other tax revenue including Cigarette, Malt Beverage, Liquor, Gaming, and other miscellaneous tax collections totaled \$176.3 million for the month of May.
- Nontax revenue collections for the month of May were \$9.4 million below estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$112.9 million, or 2.5 percent, above the official estimate.

MOTOR LICENSE AND GAMING FUNDS

Motor License Fund collections of \$301.1 million in May were \$10.7 million above the official estimate. Fiscal year 2021-22 collections of \$2.6 billion were \$30.3 million, or 1.2 percent, above the official estimate.

The State Gaming Fund collected \$104.5 million in May. Fiscal year-to-date collections for the fund total \$1,009.8 million.

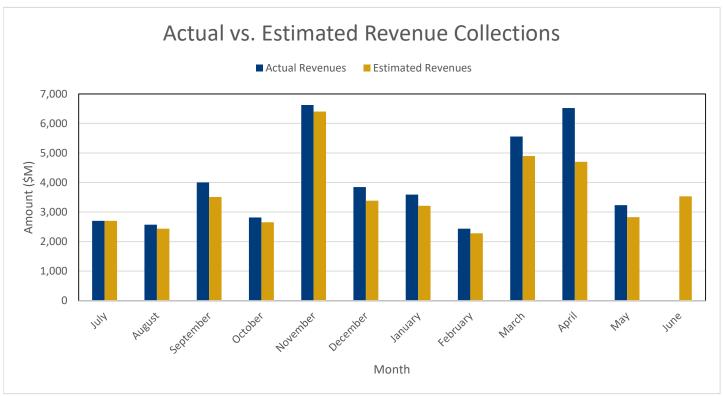

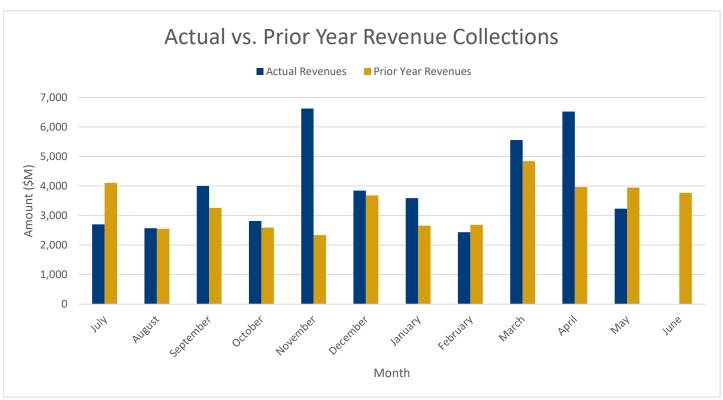

2021-22 GENERAL FUND REVENUES



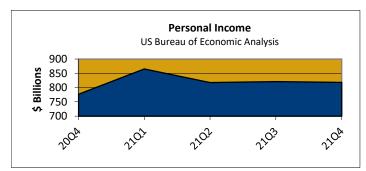


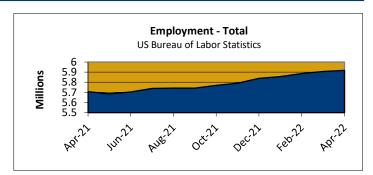
