### You may be owed a tax refund

You may be eligible for a partial or full refund of Pennsylvania personal income taxes paid in tax year 2019. These refunds are available through Pennsylvania's Tax Forgiveness program ([www.revenue.pa.gov/taxforgiveness](http://www.revenue.pa.gov/taxforgiveness)), which annually delivers refunds to more than 1 million Pennsylvanians. However, there are thousands of Pennsylvania taxpayers who qualify for Tax Forgiveness but do not take the necessary steps to claim this refund.



### What you need to do to claim your refund

**File a Pennsylvania Personal Income Tax Return (PA-40) and complete Schedule SP. You can file the PA-40 online by:**

- Going to [mypath.pa.gov](http://mypath.pa.gov) and selecting "File a PA Personal Income Tax Return for 2019" under the "Individuals" section on the homepage. myPATH is a user-friendly online filing system that will help you file the PA-40 on your own. The system will walk you through a step-by-step process to determine whether you are eligible for a refund.
- **Important:** There is no need to create a username or password on myPATH to complete the PA-40. You have the option to complete and file the return without signing up for log-in information.
- **Check your 2020 tax records:** You should also take the opportunity to review your 2020 tax records. It is possible you may also benefit from Tax Forgiveness in 2020 by filing a PA-40 for 2020 as well. You can file the 2020 return online at [mypath.pa.gov](http://mypath.pa.gov) by selecting "File a PA Personal Income Tax Return for 2020" under "Individuals" on the homepage.
