Introduction

In compliance with Article XVII-A.1 of the Tax Reform Code of 1971, as amended under Act 25 of 2021, the Department of Revenue "Department" has implemented requirements for the collection and reporting of information to the Independent Fiscal Office (IFO) for tax credit and tax benefit programs.

The Department, acting on behalf of each administering agency: Department of Community and Economic Development, State Conservation Commission and Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency shall provide the information submitted under subsection (c)(2) to the IFO for use in preparing a Tax Credit Report under Section 5 of the Act of October 30, 2017 (p.l.797, no.48), known as the Performance-Based Budgeting and Tax Credit Efficiency Act.

Electronic Filing Requirement

In our continuing effort to promote "Government that Works," the Tax Credit and Tax Benefit Accountability Report must be filed online. The Department will not accept the report in any other format.

Filing Requirement

All participants in "tax credit" and "tax benefit" programs are required to file the Tax Credit and Tax Benefit Accountability Report.

Specifically, the report must be filed:

• Within 45 days of filing an annual tax return, beginning the 1st year the tax credit or tax benefit is awarded and ending after the credit or benefit has been fully utilized.

Definitions

"Tax benefit" - Any program established by the Commonwealth in which an applicant applies for and receives any of the following: a tax abatement, tax credit, exemption, deduction, grant or monetary distribution under the following programs:

Award Identification

After the program has been identified from the drop down menu, the user is required to identify the: <u>Transferable Tax Credit Award ID</u>, <u>Amount Awarded</u> and <u>Date of the Award</u>.

This information can be found on the award letter or tax credit certificate issued by the administrating agency through which the credit application was submitted and approved through.

Credit Utilization

Following the identification of the award, the user must report how the credit was utilized in the aggregate under the award ID. This may include several years of utilizations, if the credit was carried forward and used annually over a period of time since the initial award date.

Example: If a taxpayer is awarded \$100,000.00 in tax credits on 5/1/20 and passes through \$10,000 in Calendar Year 2020 and \$10,000 in Calendar Year 2021, the taxpayer would have utilized 20,000 total and carried forward \$80,000.00.

The taxpayer will continue to file a Tax Credit and Tax Benefit Accountability Report annually, until the credit is fully utilized and information from this section will be updated per report filed.

Impact Reporting

The user is required, if applicable, to provide the total of expenses and jobs generated as a result of the receipt of the tax credit.

Sale and Assignment Identification

Tax Credit Sale/Assignment Transactions


The user will select the Add Button to return to the Tax Credit Sale/Assignment summary table.

Section IV – Acknowledgement

Users are required to check the acknowledgement box to submit the report. By checking the box, the user is signing this form electronically and consenting to this request being governed by Pennsylvania's Electronic Transactions Act, 73 P.S. § 2260.101, et seq.

By completing this action, the user understands and agrees that the selected "I Accept" check box, constitutes as an Electronic Signature (e-Signature), and the e-Signature is the legal equivalent of a handwritten signature.

Once the box is checked, the user must select the Submit Button.



Email Confirmation

The user that completed the report, will receive a confirmation email, immediately after submission of the report, which should be kept for records.
