SEPTEMBER 2022

GENERAL FUND

General Fund Collections of \$4.2 billion for the month of September were \$135.8 million, or 3.3 percent, above the official estimate. Fiscal year 2022-23 collections of \$9.8 billion were \$196.2 million, or 2.0 percent, above estimate.

- Total Corporation Tax collections of \$1.1 billion for the month of September were \$202.4 million above the official estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$197.3 million, or 16.9 percent, above estimate.
- Sales and Use Tax (SUT) collections of \$1.1 billion were \$2.3 million below estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$43.1 million, or 1.2 percent, above estimate.
- Total Personal Income Tax (PIT) collections of \$1.6 billion for the month of September were \$61.8 million below estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$68.2 million, or 1.8 percent, below the official estimate.
- Realty Transfer Tax (RTT) revenues of \$62.4 million were \$5.2 million below estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$12.9 million, or 7.5 percent, above estimate.
- Inheritance Tax revenues of \$128.2 million were \$5.1 million below estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$8.4 million, or 2.3 percent, below estimate.
- Other tax revenue including Cigarette, Malt Beverage, Liquor, Gaming, and other miscellaneous tax collections totaled \$176.7 million for the month of September.
- Nontax revenue collections for the month of September were \$9.4 million above estimate. Year-to-date collections are \$27.5 million, or 33.5 percent, above the official estimate.

MOTOR LICENSE AND GAMING FUNDS

Motor License Fund collections of \$252.8 million in September were \$34.3 million above the official estimate. Fiscal year 2022-23 collections of \$733.4 million were \$9.6 million, or 1.3 percent, above the official estimate.

The State Gaming Fund collected \$90.2 million in September. Fiscal year-to-date collections for the fund total \$283.6 million.
